# 2024 Purisima Red Wine

### The Story

Purisima Red Wine is our benchmark bottling, produced only in the finest vintages. Over the last decade, we have made nine vintages of this wine including this 2024 release. Since 2016, the Purisima has been 100% Syrah; prior to that, it was Grenache-Syrah blend. For this vintage, we combined a neutral barrel blend of Block Six with a high toned very interesting barrel from Purisima Mountain Vineyard Syrah, chosen to showcase the exceptional fruit and complexity of this great vintage. Bottled unfined and unfiltered, the 2024 is a stunning wine for an outstanding vintage. The Purisima Red Wine is only sold through Futures and is an extremely limited production of less than 50 cases, a true collector's gem.

### Winemaker Description

2024 brought a warm summer followed by a cooler harvest. September heat pushed sugars high early, but then the weather turned dry allowing us to continue hanging our crop into late October when the phenolic ripeness finally caught up. The resulting wine is a stunning wine that captures the combination of the heat and the cool. The '24 Purisima jumps from the glass with lifted dark fruits, pepper and game. The extended hang time and cool fall produced beautifully developed tannins while keeping the acidity in balance creating a wine that is forward and ripe while remaining impeccably balanced and elegant with perfect tannins and acidity that frame the ripe bold flavors. It is a memorable vintage of the Purisima Red Wine, one that will drink well upon release and age nicely for the next couple of decades.

# 2024 Purisima Mountain Vineyard Block Six Syrah

## The Story

Block Six was the first section of Purisima Mountain Vineyard to be farmed Biodynamically, a process that started in 2002. Certified like the rest of the vineyard in 2009 by Demeter, Block Six sits at the highest elevation on Purisima with soils containing rich deposits of chalky limestone. This combination of elevation and soil has made Block Six our finest Syrah since its first bottling in 2003. Several vintages ago we adjusted the clonal selection to highlight the 174 clone, a storied Hermitage selection. The result has been a quiet transformation: deeper aromatics, richer flavors, and a wine with added complexity and structure.

## Winemaker Description

Focused and intense, the 24 Block Six perfectly reflects the 2024 vintage. Forward fruit, mineral and spice soar out of the glass expressing the heat we experienced throughout the season. The fore-mouth is silky and rounded with loads of up-front fruit flavors. The mid-palette is full and round leading to a more tight-knit finish where the cooler weather during the harvest period struts its stuff showing black pepper, blackberry fruit and limestone minerality with fine tannins and very good acidity. For all its drinkability now, the back half screams for additional ageing leading us to expect that this wine will gain its balance, complexity and integration with more time in barrel and bottle. Enjoy this wine young or hold for a couple of years to watch it unfold.

# 2024 TLB Red Wine

### The Story

The 2024 marks the 18<sup>th</sup> vintage of our beloved TLB. At its core, this field blend brings together the best Cabernet and Syrah grown on the Thomas and Judith Beckmen Estate Vineyard. TLB combines the best of our Cabernet Sauvignon fruit with the juicy mouthfeel of Syrah. Named for our founder, Thomas Lawrence Beckmen, this field blend was the wine he dreamed of producing when he started the winery. It stands as a tribute to his continuous hard work and dedication to crafting world-class wines.

### Winemaker Description

The 2024 TLB is flat-out delicious! Cabernet leads on the nose with an array of aromas showing violet, graphite, earthy loam, black currant, and cassia. The mouth is broad and round with the Syrah adding an element of lift, energy, and juiciness to the finish of the wine. Dark fruits, wildflowers, mocha and leather flavors are interwoven throughout the wine where some fine tannins and balanced acidity frame the bold flavors on the long finish. Like our other 2024 vintage wines, the 24 TLB will be fantastic upon release. Solid structure and bold flavors ensure that this vintage will drink beautifully over the next couple of decades.

# 2024 Thomas and Judith Beckmen Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

### The Story

This is the fourth bottling of the Thomas and Judith Beckmen Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, a wine we began producing as a celebration of our founders, Tom and Judy Beckmen and their vision and passion for growing and crafting great wines. This vintage is a selection of just 2 of the best barrels of Cabernet Sauvignon from the vintage. In 2024, exceptional quality reached across the entire vineyard and this wine is a blend of fruit from blocks 2, 3 and 4. As always, the T and J Cabernet wine is sold as a futures exclusive wine with tiny production of less than 50 cases produced.

### Winemaker Description

Dark and intense, the 24 T and J Cabernet Sauvignon is fantastic! Bold and expressive, the wine captures the best qualities of the vintage - forward ripe fruit, beautiful depth and impeccable structure. Dark cherries, dark chocolate, loamy earth, tobacco leaf, mocha, cassis, pencil shavings and herbs highlight the aromas and flavors demonstrating the complexity of the vintage. The mouth is round and full, with ripe, fine tannins and great acidity – producing a wine is that is at once big and powerful, yet gliding and elegant. This is a worthy follow up to the hugely successful 2023 vintage and it will continue to get better. Expect it to drink well upon release, achieve more greatness with 5-7 years in the bottle, and evolve for the next 20+ years.

# 2025 Purisima Mountain Vineyard Syrah Clone #1

### The Story

Our selection of Clone #1 traces its roots to vines originally planted in 1868 at Best's Vineyard in Victoria, Australia. While we grow eight different clones of Syrah at Purisima Mountain Vineyard, this clone is our flagship single-clone bottling - simply put, when it comes to Syrah, Clone #1 is a rock star! The grapes for our Clone #1 Syrah are grown on a very steep, limestone-laden hillside, featuring two different rootstocks: 110r and 5c. In the winery, we shape the winemaking around what makes this clone special: its old-world aromatic profile.

### Winemaker Description

2025 was a dry year and one of the coolest vintages that we've ever experienced, punctuated by tropical thunderstorms that brought moisture on and off every month of harvest peaking with a 2.5-inch storm in October. It was a vintage that called for the most rigorous hand-sorting that we've ever done; yet, despite our worries about the results of the harvest, we are stunned at the outstanding quality of the wines we have produced, further proof of the quality of our vineyards and our farming methodology. The 25 Clone 1 is elegant, savory and complex. Gamey, smoky blue and black fruits weave their way through the aromas and flavors of the wine, with a heightened sense of minerality, rare for a Clone 1 bottling, showing up on the back end where the tannins and acidity elevate and frame the flavors across a long, layered finish. I don't know why we even worry about wine quality when we can produce such an exceptional wine under very complex growing conditions. Enjoy this wine upon release and over the next 15+ years.

# 2025 Purisima Mountain Vineyard Block Eight Grenache

### The Story

Block Eight is a special Grenache block that was planted in 2005, featuring our own Beckmen Grenache selection cultivated using cuttings from our finest grapevines. This proprietary selection is own-rooted and head-trained in the classic *gobule* ("cup") style of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Grown in soils similar to our Purisima Mountain Vineyard Grenache, this block produces small clusters, with small, intensely concentrated berries. The Block 8 Grenache is an annual favorite in our Futures Program and is available exclusively through Futures.

### Winemaker Description

One of the latest harvest dates on record for the Block 8, the 2025 weathered multiple rainstorms and very cool temperatures throughout the harvest, yet produced an incredible wine not to dissimilar from the exceptional 2024 vintage. Very pale in color, this Block 8 Grenache vintage is one of those deceiving Grenache wines - light in appearance but big on aroma, flavor and structure. The cool nature of fermenting and aging in the clay creates a lighter color wine due to lighter extraction. The wine bursts with complex aromas and flavors of dried herbs, framboise, bright strawberry, cherry and a streak of minerality, with a seamless texture that firms up on the back end as the grape skin tannins meld brilliantly with the tannins from the clay carrying the flavors on a long finish. This wine will drink great upon release and evolve for the next 10+ years. Delightful stuff!
