Purely Domestic Wine Report (Reviewed by Doug Wilder): 92 Points

“The nose is a taffy-like raspberry with underlying notes of graphite. The palate is ripe black raspberry, polished and lifted in mouth feel to maintain vitality. The texture is lively and focused. Drink 2017 - 2022.”

“The 2016 Grenache has a medium garnet-purple color and nose of baked cherries, black raspberries and plum preserves with touches of Chinese five spice, cracked pepper and sautéed herbs. Big, full-bodied and plushly textured, the berry preserves and spice flavors deliver a full-throttle palate and long, pepper-laced finish. Drink 2017 - 2021.”
