



## 2019 Purisima Mountain Vineyard Grenache Rosé

2019 got off to a late start due to the late season rains throughout May. The summer was mild with a foggy pattern in place most of the early summer which was followed by a dry and mild fall which kept the season on track for a late start and finish. Crop size was similar to 2018 with a few exceptions. The wines all possess the finest qualities from a milder season, bright acidity, and fresh, ripe fruit.

### Winemaking & Aging

- 100% certified biodynamic grapes
- Made from Grenache clone #362 and Estrella Syrah
- The Grenache was destemmed, crushed, and cold soaked for 6-24 hours depending on the lot and the Syrah was direct pressed
- Grapes were then pressed to stainless steel tanks and cold settled for 48 hours
- Juice was racked 13% to neutral barrel and 87% to stainless steel after settling, aged for 5 months
- No malolactic fermentation allowed
- The wine was bottled, lightly fined, and filtered in February 2020
