2019 Purisima Mountain Vineyard Grenache

2019 got off to a late start due to the late season rains throughout May. The summer was mild with a foggy pattern in place most of the early summer, followed by a dry and mild fall, keeping harvest on track for a late start and finish. Crop size was similar to 2018 with a few exceptions. The wines all possess the finest qualities from a milder season, with bright acidity and fresh, ripe fruit.

Winemaking & Aging

- Berries were hand-sorted, then cold-soaked for seven days.
- Wine was fermented using native yeast for 17 days.
- 33% of stems were added back to fermentation.
- The caps were punched down by hand twice daily.
- The wine underwent spontaneous native malolactic fermentation in-barrel
- 15 months in 27% new French oak Puncheon and 33% 2 - 4-year-old 300L French oak, remaining in neutral French oak.
