2019 Purisima Mountain Vineyard Syrah Clone #1

2019 got off to a late start due to the late season rains throughout May. The summer was mild with a foggy pattern in place most of the early summer, followed by a dry and mild fall, keeping harvest on track for a late start and finish. Crop size was similar to 2018 with a few exceptions. The wines all possess the finest qualities from a milder season, with bright acidity and fresh, ripe fruit.

Winemaking & Aging

- This individual lot of Syrah was 100% destemmed, hand sorted, and gently crushed.
- Lot was cold-soaked for 48 hours to extract color and taste-enhancing phenolics.
- Fermented using native yeast.
- The caps were punched down by hand twice daily.
- The wine underwent spontaneous malolactic fermentation in barrel to integrate fruit and texture.
- Aged 16 months in 52.4% new French oak and 47.6% neutral oak; 100% Mercurey barrels.
